- Website Visitors: We may collect non-personally identifying information such as browser type, language preference, referring site, and the date and time of each visitor request to better understand how visitors use our website.

We may share your information with your referring vet if there are any concerns or updates maintaining paraprofessional communication; however, you have agreed for this data sharing to occur when booking with us, and it is necessary for professional practice. Information shared with the vet should also be protected under their privacy policy.
